

Resolution No. 22.0711.03

A Resolution Amending City Electric Rates

WHEREAS, the Parker City Council believes that it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Parker, in order to pay all costs for the operation and maintenance of the Parker City electric system, to amend the rates for the sale of electricity provided by the City of Parker; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.0103 of the Parker City Ordinances gives the Parker City Council the authority to revise rates for the use of utilities to be established by Resolution of the Parker City Council, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PARKER CITY COUNCIL that the charge for large power electric rates shall be amended as follows:

That the monthly service charge will be \$28.00; the monthly demand charge shall be \$12.25 per KW of billing demand; and the energy charge for all KWH shall be 5.40 cents per KWH.

This rate change is effective beginning with the August 1, 2022 bill, due August 20, 2022.

This Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and support of the municipal government and its existing institutions and shall take effect immediately upon the passage and publication thereof pursuant to SDCL 9-19-13.
