

**COUNCIL MINUTES  
CITY OF PARKER REGULAR MEETING  
Monday, January 11, 2021 7:00 p.m.**

The Parker City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 11, 2021 in the council room of City Hall. Members present: Council members: Harms, Nogelmeier Herlyn, Erickson and Berens. Absent: Mayor Nelson and Schulte. Other persons attending: Finance Officer Jans, Mike Jorgensen, Sarah Ebeling, Kathy Rand, Thad Cotton, and Francis Iverson. Council President Berens declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

All action in following minutes carried by unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.

21.01 Motion by Harms, seconded by Nogelmeier to approve the December 7, and December 29, 2020 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried.

21.02 Motion by Nogelmeier, seconded by Erickson to approve the January claims as presented. List attached. Motion carried. December salaries: General Fund: \$27,776.21. Enterprise Funds: \$13,389.64. TOTAL: \$41,165.85.

Public Comments: Son of Leonard Dyer was present to discuss his RV living situation on his father's property. Discussion at length was had. Resident was made aware he will have until March 10, 2021 to find other housing options.

21.03 Motion by Nogelmeier, seconded by Herlyn to approve the liquor license for Twisted Pines Venue. Motion carried.

21.04 Motion by Herlyn, seconded by Harms to approve the alcohol consumption at the community building January 16, 2021 for the Fire Dept. stag. Motion carried.

21.05 Motion by Herlyn, seconded by Erickson to approve the first reading of amended ordinance 7.0501. Motion carried.

Department Reports: Deputy Pulford and Deputy Kirvin were present to answer any questions. Finance Officer Jans explained to the deputies that when a snow alert is issued, no vehicles can be parked on the street, boulevard or sidewalk and should be ticketed. Library Director Rand was present to give a end of year update, and noted most IRS tax forms are now available at the library. Street Superintendent Jorgensen discussed the proposed parking plan around the school. Jorgensen also noted the first snow alert went well, the second one not so much and seems to be a constant battle to work that out. Finance Officer Jans explained the 2021 salaries and 2021 election date need to be approved.
