

**COUNCIL MINUTES**  
**CITY OF PARKER**  
**Monday, January 13, 2025, 7:00 p.m.**

The Parker City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 13, 2025, in the council room of City Hall. Members present: Council members: Harms, RBuller, JBuller, Poncelet, Kuchta, Janzen, and Mayor Nolan. Others in attendance: Finance Officer Jans, Mick Miller, Tricia Erickson, and Audrea Buller. Mayor Nolan declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

All action in the following minutes was carried out by unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.

- 25.01 Motion by Harms, seconded by RBuller to approve the December 9, and December 30, 2024, meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried.
