

**COUNCIL MINUTES  
CITY OF PARKER REGULAR MEETING  
Monday April 8, 2024 7:00 p.m.**

The Parker City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 8, 2024, in the council room of City Hall. Members present: Council members: Harms, RBuller, JBuller, Poncelet, Kuchta, Janzen, and Mayor Nolan. Other persons present: Finance Officer Jans, Tom Rauenhorst, Austin Clarke, Tricia Erickson, and Interim Sheriff Buteyn. Mayor Nolan declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
