

**COUNCIL MINUTES  
CITY OF PARKER REGULAR MEETING  
Monday, June 10, 2024 7:00 p.m.**

The Parker City Council met in regular session on Monday, June 10, 2024 in the council room of City Hall. Members present: Council members: Harms, RBuller, JBuller, Poncelet, Kuchta, and Mayor Nolan. Absent: Janzen. Others attending: Finance Officer Jans, Tanya Wickstrom, Audrea Buller, Jim Kasten, Darrell Buller and Sheriff Buteyn. Mayor Nolan declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

All action in the following minutes was carried out by unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.

- 24.62 Motion by JBuller, seconded by Kuchta to approve the May 13, 2024, regular meeting minutes. Motion carried.
- 24.63 Motion by Harms, seconded by RBuller to approve the June claims as presented and to include Heartland and East River. List attached. Motion carried. May salaries: General Fund: \$50,189.09. Enterprise Fund: \$31,602.99. Total salaries: \$81,792.08.
- 24.64 Motion by RBuller, seconded by Poncelet to increase lifeguard wages to \$13.50/hr starting wage, with an increase of \$0.25/hr for each year returning, and to backpay previous hours worked for 2024. Motion carried.
- 24.65 Motion by Poncelet, seconded by JBuller to approve lifeguards Terryn Fuller and Shelby Spann. Motion carried.

The council made a unanimous decision for Finance Officer/Administrator Jans to remain as Delegate, and Mayor Nolan to remain as Alternate for the Lewis & Clark Board of Directors.

- 24.67 Motion by RBuller, seconded by Poncelet to approve Pay Application #6 – Draw #9 Phase 6 Utility Improvement Project. Motion carried.
- 24.68 Motion by Kuchta, seconded by Harms to approve the Schoenfish Engagement Letter for the 2023 Audit. Motion carried.

Discussion was had regarding the Nelson Feed Lot on North Main Avenue. Council tabled discussion.
