

COUNCIL MINUTES
CITY OF PARKER REGULAR MEETING
Tuesday, October 10, 2023 7:00 p.m.

The Parker City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, October 10, 2023 in the council room of City Hall. Members present: Council members: Harms, RBuller, Poncelet, Janzen and Mayor Nolan. Absent: JBuller. Kuchta joined via phone. Other people attending: Finance Officer Jans, Tricia Erickson and Shane Jibben. Mayor Nolan declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

All action in the following minutes was carried out by unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.

- 23.94 Motion by RBuller, seconded by Poncelet to approve the September 11, 2023 regular meeting minutes and September 25, 2023 special meeting minutes. Motion carried.
- 23.95 Motion by Harms, seconded by Janzen to approve the October claims as presented except Parker Pharmacy, and to include East River. List attached. Motion carried. September salaries: General Fund: \$25,891.70. Enterprise Fund: \$21,643.43. Total salaries: \$47,535.13.
- 23.96 Motion by Janzen, seconded by RBuller to approve claim to Parker Pharmacy. Poncelet abstained. Motion carried.
- 23.97 Motion by RBuller, seconded by Poncelet to allow the high school and youth wrestling programs to utilize the community building for practice, but ask that the school pay the Northwestern utility bill for those months. Harms abstained. Motion carried.
- 23.98 Motion by Harms, seconded by Poncelet to approve pay application #2 for Metro Construction. Motion carried.
- 23.99 Motion by Harms, seconded by RBuller increase the RV park rates to \$25/full hookup and \$20/electric only per night beginning January 1, 2024. Motion carried.

Council Concerns: Harms advised she was approached regarding a joint venture to repair picnic tables at the rec complex. Kuchta gave an update on the new backstop on field one and gave a shout out to Groeneweg Construction for their help. Mayor Nolan thanked all those that helped with city wide cleanup.

Department Reports: Library Director Erickson and Finance Officer Jans gave monthly updates.
