

**COUNCIL MINUTES  
CITY OF PARKER  
Monday, November 8, 2021 7:00 P.M.**

The Parker City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 8, 2021 in Council Chambers of City Hall. Members present: Council members: Harms, Deelstra, Poncelet, Kuchta, Janzen and Mayor Nelson. Absent: Berens. Other persons present: Finance Officer Jans, Mike Jorgensen, Donna Rumbaugh, Derek Nolan, Dustin & Tanya Wickstrom, Audrea Buller and Savannah Roebuck. Mayor Nelson declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

All action taken in the following minutes carried by unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.

- 21.131 Motion by Poncelet, seconded by Kuchta to approve the October 11, 2021 regular meeting minutes and October 20, 2021 special meeting minutes. Motion carried.
- 21.132 Motion by Harms, seconded by Poncelet to approve the November claims as presented. List Attached. October salaries: General Fund: \$28,654.76. Enterprise Fund: \$12,270.29. Total October Salaries: \$40,925.05. Motion carried.
- 21.133 Motion by Deelstra, seconded by Kuchta to allow both Parker High School and Parker Youth wrestling access to the community building for practice. Motion carried.
- 21.134 Motion by Harms, seconded by Kuchta to approve the SECOG Voter Ward Redistricting agreement. Motion carried.
- 21.135 Motion by Poncelet, seconded by Harms to approve Resolution No. 21.1108.01 – Amendment to Employee Personnel Manual. Motion carried.
- 21.136 Motion by Poncelet, seconded by Janzen to approve the 2022 Liquor Licenses for Twisted Pines, Jones Food Center, Kelley’s Bar and TJ Kerner’s. Motion carried.
- 21.137 Motion by Harms, seconded by Poncelet to surplus the 2007 6x12 Carry On trailer. Motion carried.

Department Reports: Street Superintendent Jorgensen shared that he had been approached about removing a doublewide for a property owner. Jorgensen explained he has looked at the home and his recommendation would be to help with what we can, but due to circumstances on the property Jorgensen would suggest the property owner hires an excavator. Council consensus was to have property owner hire an excavator and the city would provide trucks to haul debris away. Finance Officer Jans discussed with the council the option of surplus the 2002 Chevy Silverado with the plow. Consensus was to surplus the truck with the plow and purchase a new plow for the 2015 Silverado 3500.
